



## **Hugh Smith Community Service Award PRSA Puget Sound Chapter Guidelines and Nomination Information**

(updated July 2008)

The Hugh Smith Community Service Award recognizes a Puget Sound area public relations professional who has demonstrated outstanding citizenship by contributing public relations expertise to an important community issue and/or non-profit organization(s) across the span of the candidate's career.

### Eligibility

Any public relations professional serving in the Puget Sound area is eligible. Nominees do not need to be a PRSA member.

### Selection

A judging committee of three or more chapter members and board members will select a winner from among the nominees. The committee can elect to not present an award in any year if, in their judgment, a suitable candidate does not exist. The award will be presented at the PRSA Holiday Gala on December 2, 2008.
